New opportunities and a transitioning workforce means lots of options and places to grow.

Did you know?
131,000 Canadians are employed in the plant science industry.⁴

- Enrolments in ag programs grew at a rate double all post-secondary enrolments over the past five years.⁵
- Food processing employs 246,000 Canadians in more than 6,500 facilities across the country.⁶

- There will be 114,000 on-farm job opportunities by 2025. 45,900 of these opportunities will be for farm owners and managers.³
- More than one in four agriculture workers are forecast to retire by 2025.³
